Glossary

Acoustics - the way in which the structure of a building or room affects the qualities of musical or spoken sound

Audience - the group of people together in one place to watch or listen to a play, film or concert

Conductor - someone who directs the performance of musicians or a piece of music

Ensemble - a group of things, especially a group of musicians who regularly play together

Leader - the principal first violinist in an orchestra, often serving as assistant to the conductor

Pads - the folders in which sheet music is stored on stage

Rehearsal - a time when all the people involved in a performance practise in order to prepare

Repertoire - all the music, plays, dances, operas, etc., that a person or a group can perform, or that exist in a particular type of activity related to the arts

Soloist - a musician who performs a solo

Tempo - the speed at which a piece of music is played
